Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project

Services started in May 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD in 2024, with new metro railway stations at Crows Nest, Victoria Cross, Barangaroo, Martin Place, Gadigal and Waterloo, and new metro platforms at Central, and then onto Bankstown in 2025.

Laing O'Rourke delivered the new Sydney Metro platforms under Central Station as well as the landmark Central Walk - a new underground pedestrian concourse to help customers get around Sydney's busiest railway station.

Night work on Platforms 22-23

From **8pm-4am Monday 19 to Friday 23 February 2024**, work will be undertaken to remove and replace a number of tiles on Platforms 22-23, as well as to complete grouting and joint sealing. For safety reasons, this work is required to be undertaken when trains are not running.

What to expect

- Machinery and equipment used during this work includes handheld grinder, generator, construction tools including hand and power tools, jack hammers.
- Noise mitigation measures, including noise blankets and monitoring, will be in place during the works.
