

## Out of hours work notification - Clarke Street paving works

Work commencing Monday 12 February 2024

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD in 2024, with new metro railway stations at Crows Nest, Victoria Cross, Barangaroo, Martin Place, Gadigal and Waterloo, and new metro platforms at Central, and then onto Bankstown in 2025.

A W Edwards is building the new Crows Nest Station. Rail track installation and the stations main structural works are now complete and fit out and exterior works are progressing.

### Clarke Street out-of-hours work

Commencing **Monday 12 February**, work will be carried out to repave the footpath on Clarke Street, between the corner of Hume Lane and Clarke Street and Willoughby Road. To maintain access to businesses in this area, this work will occur out-of-hours, between **3pm and 12am the following morning**. This is expected to take **up to five nights to complete**.

Work on **Monday 12 and Tuesday 13 February** will be noisy, as it will involve cutting and jackhammering to remove the existing footpath. High noise activities **will cease by 12 midnight**.

Work on **Wednesday 14, Thursday 15 and Friday 16 February** will involve paving the footpath which is expected to be low noise. Any high noise activities such as cutting of pavers will occur during the day.

Footpath access will be restricted, and pedestrian diversions will be in place. Parking will be removed adjacent to work areas to assist with truck and utility vehicles.

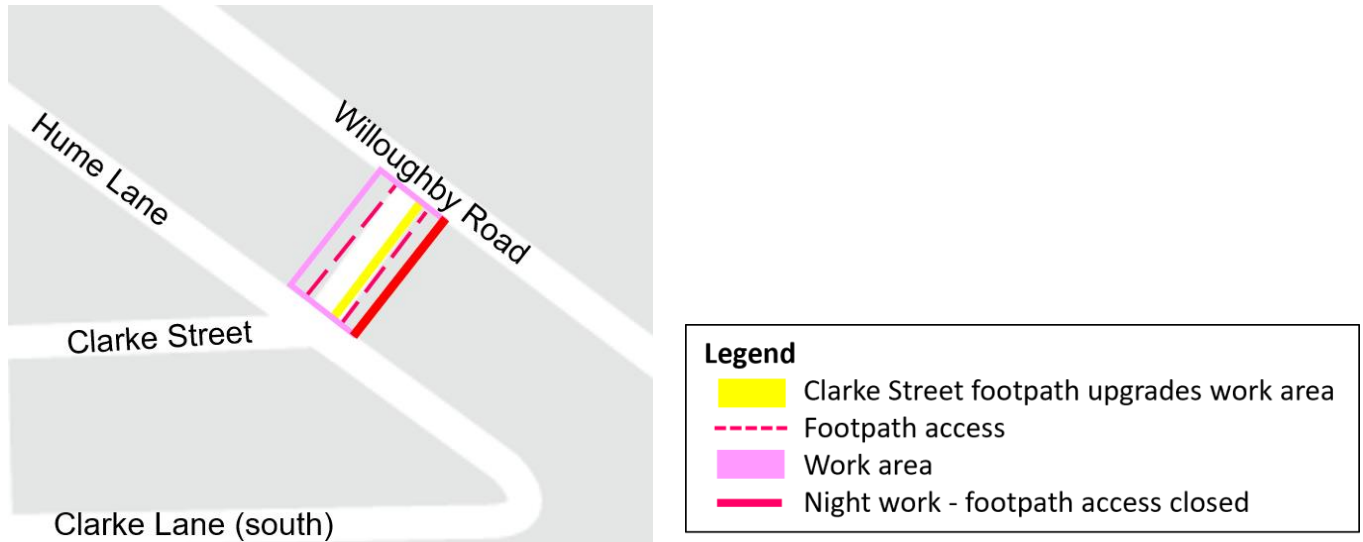
### Work hours

Work to repave the footpath will occur between **3pm and 12am** the following morning for up to **five nights during the week**, weather permitting.

### What to expect

Some of these works will **be noisy** as we will be cutting and digging into the footpath. **High noise works will stop at midnight**. Vacuum trucks will be used to remove dirt and debris.
