Notification – Pyrmont utility work

April 2024

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, link new communities to rail services and support employment growth and housing supply.

John Holland CPB Contractors Ghella Joint Venture (JCG) has been awarded the contract to deliver 3.5 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Hunter Street and to excavate the Pyrmont and Hunter Street metro stations.

In April, we will undertake utility work to provide permanent power supply to our Pyrmont East worksite. Work is scheduled between **Sunday 7 April** and **Sunday 19 April**. Work will take place both during the day and at night. Specific dates will be notified in our weekly email update.

Upcoming utility work

Work will take place on Union Street, Darling Drive and next to Pyrmont Bridge. Please see map over the page for locations of our work. Activities will include:

- Setting up of traffic management near locations to maintain traffic flow
- Temporary disruption to roads and footpaths
- Use of vacuum truck to remove water from pits
- Using hand tools to install cables.

Equipment and machinery used

May include but is not limited to a vacuum truck, lighting towers, traffic control equipment, hand tools and generators.

What will this mean for you?

During work, you may notice:

- Temporary lights will be set up and directed at the site for safety purposes
- Some intermittent noise
- Access to pathways and buildings will be maintained at all times
- Parking may be temporarily restricted in some locations
- Traffic control and directional signage may be used for the safety of works and the community.

Managing our impacts

Construction activities may generate increased noise and will be mitigated on site, where possible.

We aim to reduce impacts on the community and the environment by:

- Finishing high noise impact activities by 10pm
- Directing lighting away from properties.
