

Project update – Victoria Cross

April 2024

Sydney Metro is Australia’s biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city’s North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD in 2024, with new metro railway stations at Crows Nest, Victoria Cross, Barangaroo, Martin Place, Gadigal and Waterloo, and new metro platforms at Central, and then onto Bankstown in 2025.

Lendlease will deliver the new Sydney Metro Victoria Cross integrated station development at North Sydney, including the metro station, over station development (OSD) and enhancements to pedestrian connections, retail and public spaces.

What work are we doing?

Upcoming out-of-hours work – Victoria Cross

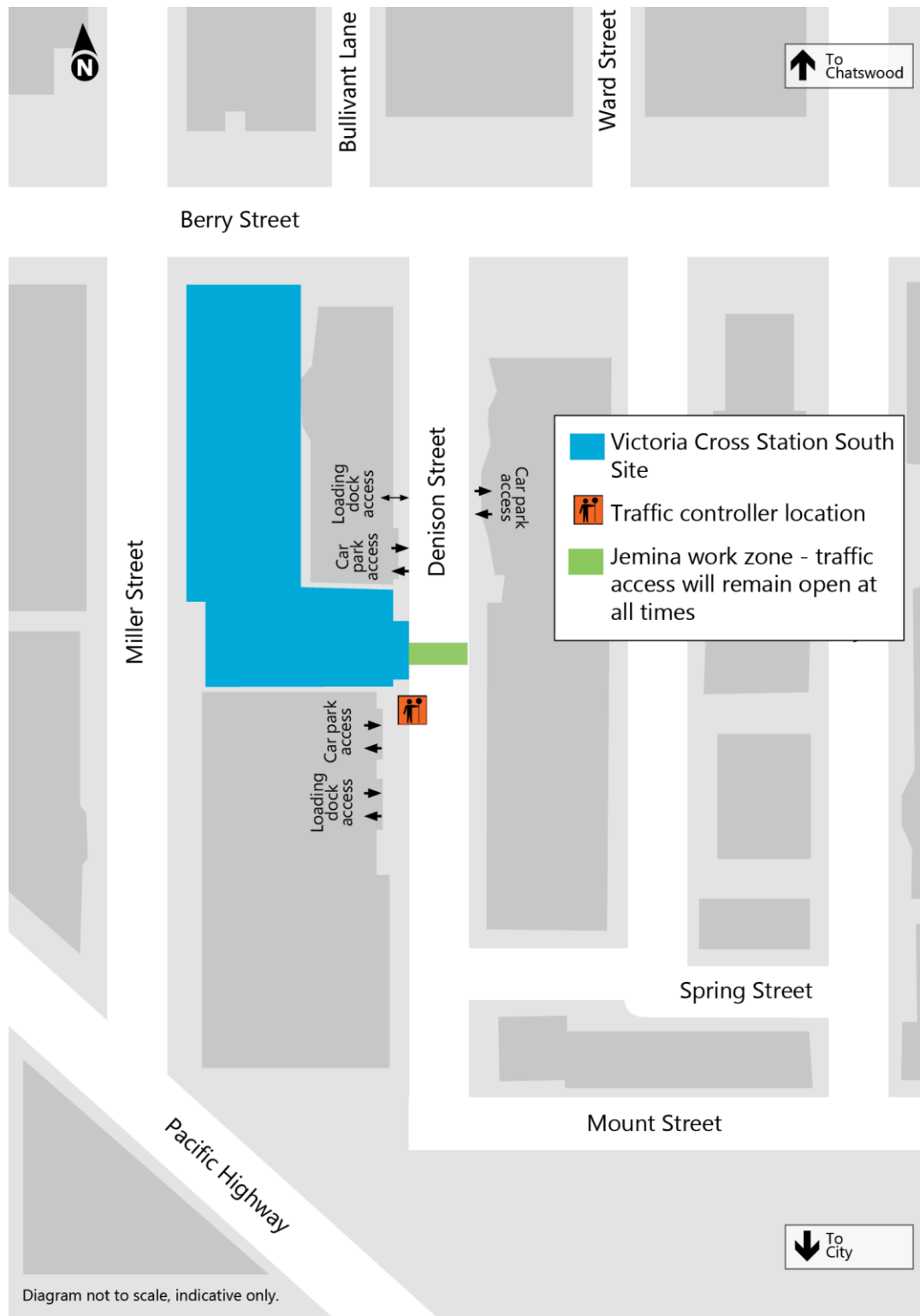
The table below is an indicative schedule of out-of-hours work on Denison Street. These works are in addition to those previously notified.

Dates and times	Location(s)	Work
Sunday 21 April to Wednesday 24 April, 8pm to 5am	South site adjacent to Denison Street	Jemena will be completing works to connect Victoria Cross Station to the local gas line. Works within the south site include: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• saw cutting and excavation via vacuum truck• truck and small machinery movements• connection of services.
Sunday 28 April to Monday 3 May, 7pm to 5am *contingency dates : 4 May to 8 May 7pm to 5am	Denison Street	Works on Denison Street include: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• establishing the work zones on Denison Street. Through access will be maintained• saw cutting and excavation via vacuum truck• truck and small machinery movements• connection of services.

What to expect

- Traffic, street parking and pedestrian changes to surrounding streets. Access to buildings and driveways will always be maintained.
- Traffic control and directional signage will be in place for the safety of workers, pedestrians and the community.
- Some of these activities will be noisy. The project team will limit these impacts where possible. Noisiest works, including saw cutting, will be completed by 12am. Non-tonal reversing beepers will be used. Workers will be instructed to keep noise to a minimum.
